## PRESCHOOL PROGRAM COMING SOON TO HIGHLAND VIEW!

Central Baptist has voted to close their weekly preschool program and Highland View has offered to continue the preschool at our location. What a great opportunity the Lord has provided for us to be a part of serving others! Starting June 8th, 2010, it will be open on Tuesday and Thursday of every week from 9am to 2pm for 6 weeks through 5 years old (preK). It is \$15 per day for the first child and \$8 for siblings as well as a \$50 once per school year registration fee per child. This fee covers supplies, photo developing and other costs that the preschool may incur for the program to better serve the children. In the summer, there will be a program called "Summer Safari". It is for those that have just completed Kindergarten through 6th grade. They do some off campus field trips and other activities. The cost will be determined. Highland View will have to build a new playground and do some classroom changes, so we are taking donations to meet a goal of \$15,000. So far, \$9,500 has been donated or pledged. Thank you!!
